





# Examination report

It is important to practice writing <u>extended responses</u> in <u>Greek within the specified time</u> as some students did not complete their responses with <u>appropriate level of detail</u>. Some responses were brief and did not adhere to the word range (200–300 words).

Students should <u>pay attention to the audience and the text type</u>. A few students wrote the report on a cultural event as a speech (Question 5); others did not include the characteristics of an article in Question 7.

In this text type, students needed to include <u>evaluative language</u> such as impersonal expressions, use of third person, and expressions such as 'on one hand', 'on the other hand' etc.

Most responses <u>lacked depth</u> and the writing was not always organised as an article. Some students did not adhere to the requirements of the text type and the style of writing.

# Greek Exam 2020, Question 8

- You have seen the image below on a poster. In your diary, record your thoughts about the world of the future, inspired by this image.

## Examination report

They could use the image as a springboard and <u>use any elements of the image</u> to write their personal thoughts, views, concerns and hopes for the world in the future.

This question was answered well by many students who expressed their thoughts on issues such as pollution, the need to recycle, disregard for our planet etc.

Some responses, however, did not score highly because they appeared to integrate <u>pre-prepared content about the environment</u> and wrote in an informative style, <u>without responding specifically to the visual image</u>.

Other responses that did not score highly included other unrelated content and only touched on the topic in the conclusion.
